Section 2- Program Requested: The Dandelion Room Toddler Program (2yr - 3yr)

The NSM Toddler program is a one year preparatory classroom for toddlers aged 2 - 3yrs. Our Montessori Guides will help assist with toilet training, independence, and readiness for the NSM primary classroom.

Students are encouraged to explore practical life activities, develop independent and careful movement throughout the classroom space, and interact with adults and peers daily to deepen cognitive and language skills. During this time, children will develop a sense of confidence, routine, and an understanding of the purpose of the Montessori materials. Activities in the Dandelion Room will focus on fostering independence through creative arts, social/emotional development, control of movement, and self-paced practical life, sensorial, math, language, and cultural activities. Children will be exposed to daily circle time songs, story time, games, and music and movement. This important developmental work fosters readiness for the academic progress made in the primary years.

Toilet Training: Prior to enrollment, parents should have started toilet training with their toddler, and are willing to work with an NSM Toddler Guide to ensure that their child is becoming more independent and familiar with consistent selfcare practices at home. It is important that the school and home work together for potty training success.

Primary Program (3yr – 6yr)

The NSM Primary age program is prepared with intention and designed to meet the needs of your child for a three year academic cycle. Readiness for the primary program is determined by Ms. Jessica after careful observation of your child during their day to day activities, or attendance in the toddler classroom.

The focus of primary classroom activities revolves around 5 key Areas:

Practical Life: The term Practical Life is used to describe those exercises which involve everyday activities with materials often found in your own household. These exercises form the basis of the child's physical, intellectual, emotional, and social development. Students begin with familiar activities such as spooning, transferring with tongs, wiping, and pouring, and students are free to explore within safe boundaries.

Sensorial: Sensory materials have been developed to facilitate the formation of ordered thought. Children will often taste, touch, and listen to sounds they create by interacting with their environment. The senses can be categorized by visual, tactile, auditory, olfactory, gustatory, thermic, baric, stereognostic, and chromatic. By deepening the cognitive connections of these senses, children develop the capacity for deeper concentration and abstract thought while they explore other areas.

Language: A child's natural tendency towards increasingly more complex work will lead them towards picture recognition, word association, commands, phrases, and ultimately sentences. Children come to recognize phonetic symbols as representative ideas and sounds, paving the way to more complex abstractions such as reading comprehension and exposure to multiple languages.

Mathematics: Maria Montessori believed that children are naturally attracted to numbers and born with a "mathematical mind", which is built up with exactity based on the order and perceptual awareness found in the development of the senses. These sensorial impressions allow the child to create mental order which leads to reasoning and differentiation.

Culture: Maria Montessori felt that having an understanding of a diverse set of subjects developed a more "cultured" individual. Traditionally this includes the arts and sciences, but at NSM, we also focus on the cultures that are represented in the student population. Materials are refreshed weekly as topics and areas of

study change throughout the year. We explore art concepts, scientific principles, as well as people, food, holidays, and music from around the world.

Policies

- Nature Song Montessori is not a traditional day care and does not provide care during vacations and Holidays.
- Lunch shall be provided by the parents. Nature Song Montessori will provide nutritional morning and afternoon snacks daily.
- Parents are responsible for providing a small blanket for nap -time and changes of clothing. Any soiled clothing will be sent home to be laundered by the parent.
 Nap blankets will be sent home to be washed every other Friday and returned to school the following Monday.
- Children may not attend when ill, with active cold symptoms, fever, or any communicable illness.
- Children will have outdoor time daily except in extreme weather conditions and should be clothed appropriately.
- There shall be absolutely no drop in's without prior notification to the owner
- We encourage a no sugar policy with exceptions to certain holidays and request that the children do not bring sweets to school. Home baked goods are welcome.
- Your child's birthday is celebrated with a traditional Montessori classroom celebration usually in the morning. A birthday packet will be sent home a week before with recommendations for birthday treats. We will not plan or host large birthday parties at school.
- Sharing will encourage your child to develop articulation skills and confidence. Your child is encouraged to bring educational items that may reflect the learning topic. The weekly theme will be posted on the Parent News board and in monthly newsletters. Toys shall be kept at home. Sharing is every Thursday.
- Class time and morning routines begin promptly at 8:05. Children are busy from the moment they arrive and we appreciate your support by entering the classroom quietly and not to disrupt any activities already in progress.
- Observations may be made by appointment only and given a time frame of 20-30 minutes.
- In an effort to preserve the beauty of our Montessori environment, we ask that all children remove their shoes before entering the school, and that parents reinforce this at drop off. You may provide house slippers for your child for indoor activity.

Please list any restrictions to permission of the following

- My child may be taken on field trips or neighborhood walking excursions under required supervision of NSM Staff. Occasionally parents may be asked to meet offsite for field trips.
- My child may participate in water activities under required supervision with NSM Staff.
- NSM will often take video and images of my child for the purposes of promotional and documentary photography. These images are used for education and awareness building of our program, in addition to our end of year slideshows. I give my permission for NSM to use these images taken:
 - o On-site
 - Off-Site on excursions and field trips.
- My child may be given non-prescribed medication as indicated on the container. This may include sunscreen, children's pain reliever, antibacterial first aid cream, and diapering ointment. Syrup of ipecac may be administered if deemed necessary by the poison control operator. The child's parent or guardian will be contacted prior to administering non-prescription pain relievers. Prescription medications must be current and a permission slip is required per each medication.

In an emergency, the child-care facility has my permission to call an ambulance, or take my child to any available physician or hospital at my expense to obtain medical treatment. In most emergencies, 911 is called and the child is transported to the nearest hospital and treated by the on-call physician. The parent or guardian of the child is notified as soon as possible.
